TITLE: AB NICHOLAS SCHOLARSHIP
SPONSOR: Albert Nicholas - Nicholas Company
SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: This scholarship is for any boy or girl who participated in the school basketball program, but aren't likely to receive an athletic scholarship or even play basketball at the college level. Student must be a resident of WI, a public high school student, participated in the program their senior year and plan to attend a University of Wisconsin System school.
VALUE: \$10,000 for four year program or \$5000 for two year program renewable

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: Three \$1,000 scholarships are being made available to high school seniors planning to further their education at a college, university or technical college. AHS is one school that has been selected for 2024-25 school year.

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: The Ashwaubenon Alumni Association Community Service Scholarship is available to an Ashwaubenon High School senior enrolled at Ashwaubenon High School not less than two semesters prior to graduation, is eligible to receive a diploma, has achieved an academic record that represents the student's maximum effort, and is pursuing some form of post-secondary education. Desirable personal character, demonstrated leadership and pride in community, strong work ethic, and proven commitment of service to school and/or community is an important criterion. Preference will be given to service completed within the Village of Ashwaubenon and to those involved in a variety of services benefitting the community. **Applications for seniors will be available January 10th and are due March 12th.**

TITLE: **THE ASHWAUBENON BOWLING ALLEY SCHOLARSHIP**

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: The Ashwaubenon Bowling Alley Scholarship is available to an Ashwaubenon High School senior enrolled at Ashwaubenon High School not less than two semesters prior to graduation, is eligible to receive a diploma, has achieved an academic record that represents the student's maximum effort, and is pursuing some form of post-secondary education. **Applications for seniors will be available January 10th and are due March 12th.**

VALUE: \$500

TITLE: **ASHWAUBENON GIRLS SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

SPONSOR: same

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: Must have played a minimum of 4 seasons (between Little League & Babe Ruth League) of AGSA softball. Student must have participated for one year in AHS softball program. Student must have been accepted by a college or technical school for a 2 or 4 - year program. Student must have an overall G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher. Student must exemplify attitudes of good sportsmanship and fair play. Student must be in good standing at Ashwaubenon High School. **Applications for seniors will be available January 10th and are due March 12th.**

TITLE: **ASHWAUBENON HIGH SCHOOL GERMAN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**

SPONSOR: Ashwaubenon High School German Club

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: To apply for this scholarship the student must be a graduating senior who has completed German V or Seminar Deutsch as a senior at AHS. During the fall semester following her/his senior year, the recipient must be a full-time student at an accredited college or university and be enrolled in a German class. **Applications for seniors will be available January 10th and are due March 12th.**

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: The student must have been an active member of Student Council for at least two years, one of which must be in the senior year. Applicants will be evaluated on leadership and involvement in Student Council, extracurricular activities, and community activities. Written essay is required.

TITLE: ASHWAUBENON JAGUAR BACKERS SCHOLARSHIP
SPONSOR: Ashwaubenon Jaguar Backers
SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: Any senior may apply who is planning on attending a 2 or 4 year, post-secondary program. The student's G.P.A. needs to be a 2.75 or better.
YOU DO NOT NEED TO BE AN ATHLETE TO APPLY.

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: This scholarship is open to any student who has a 2.0 cumulative grade point average or above and is intended for a student attending a **technical college**.

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: This scholarship is open to any student who has a 2.0 cumulative grade point average or above. **Student can attend a 2/4 year college/university /technical college.**
Three scholarships will be awarded – 1 for those attending a technical college and 2 for those attending a two/four year college. Leadership and service to school and community is an important criterion.

REQUIREMENTS: This scholarship is open to any Ashwaubenon student that participated in Ashwaubenon Lions Football in both 7th and 8th grade and Ashwaubenon High School Football at the Varsity level. Student must be attending a university or technical college for a two or four year program. GPA must be 3.0 or higher. Student must exemplify qualities of good sportsmanship and fair play.

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: The scholarship will be applied to any four-year college or university or technical college. An essay will be required with this scholarship.

SPONSOR: The Ashwaubenon Retired Fire Company #213
SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: The Ashwaubenon Retired Fire Company Scholarship is available to an Ashwaubenon High School senior who is seeking to enter the field of Police, Fire or Rescue Programs. The recipient will have a C average or better. An essay is required for this scholarship.
Applications for seniors will be available January 10th and are due March 12th.

TITLE: **ASHWAUBENON SOCCER BOOSTER CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**
SPONSOR: Ashwaubenon Soccer Booster Club
SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: Must exemplify attitudes of good sportsmanship and fair play, as well as leadership on and off the field. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. Must have been enrolled at AHS for not less than two semesters prior to graduation, eligible for a diploma from AHS and be accepted by a college, technical college or apprenticeship trade program at an accredited institution.

TITLE: **ASHWAUBENON SUBSTITUTE TEACHER ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP**

SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: Must have been enrolled in Ashwaubenon High School for a period of not less than 3 semesters prior to graduation. Maintain a 3.0 GPA for six semesters prior to graduation. This scholarship is based on academic performance in high school, a career in education, demonstrated leadership ability & participation in school and community activities.
Applications for seniors will be available January 10th and are due March 12th.

TITLE: **ASHWAUBENON WRESTLING CLUB SCHOLARSHIP**
SPONSOR: Ashwaubenon Wrestling Club
SPEC. REQUIREMENTS: Available to any senior who has wrestled or worked as a wrestling manager/statistician at Ashwaubenon High School. Applicant must have been enrolled at AHS for a period of not less than 2 semesters prior to graduation.
