


If your student is missing a certain item, please, check our Lost and Found table(located in our school cafeteria). You may stop in after

FALL 2024 VIRTUAL PARENT/TEACHER/STUDENT CONFERENCES

The Fall 2024 Virtual Parent/Teacher Conferences are almost here!

On Wednesday, November 6th from 4-7:30 p.m. and on Thursday, November 7th from Noon until 7:30 p.m., Parkview parents, guardians, caregivers have an opportunity to meet with some or all of their student's teachers to discuss their student's progress so far this school year.

***Please note: the scheduling window in Conference Manager will close on Monday, November 4th at 6:00 p.m. If you do not schedule conferences before this deadline and you still want to meet with your student's teachers, you will need to reach out to each individual teacher via email and set up a time to meet outside of our school day.

COLD WEATHER ALERT!

With the coldest weather months right around the corner, we wanted to remind you of a few important things:

Students are allowed to enter the building each morning at 7:30

 a.m. unless they are eating school breakfast in our cafeteria.
 Students are not to bring their own breakfast items into the cafeteria during breakfast time. Students that are eating a school-sponsored breakfast are allowed to enter at 7:10 a.m.



- All other students who are not eating breakfast will need to wait to enter the building. Please, make sure that they are dressed for the outside elements.
- 2. Also, our students need to vacate the building each day by 3:00 p.m. unless they are participating in an after school-related event. Our supervision ends at 3:00 p.m. so students will be waiting outside to be picked up after this time.
- 3. Even in the cold months of December, January, and February, the students will be going outside for recess on most days. When going out for recess, it is another instance when we want our students to be protected against the cold. Students will have the option to remain inside if they want to play card games or sit and talk quietly with friends.

We know that by working with you, our students can be outside safely because they are dressed appropriately.
