## STUDENTS LEAVING SCHOOL EARLY

If your child needs to leave school during the day, please send an email to [vvattendance@ashwaubenonk12.org](mailto:vvattendance@ashwaubenonk12.org) prior to or the morning of the early release.

The email should include:

- the student's full name and teacher
- the time and date they will be picked up
- who will be picking them up
- the reason for leaving

Sending an email will eliminate classroom interruptions and maximize instructional time. Any student leaving during the day must be signed out by an adult. Please note that leaving school before the 3:15 dismissal bell will be reflected on the student's attendance.
