Dear Parent/Guardian:

Pioneer K-4 students who would like to check out books to read over the summer will be allowed to get up to 10 books the last week of school, however, families must meet the following conditions:

- have a signed parent/guardian permission form on file,
- have all school-year books returned, and
- be returning to Pioneer School next school year.

In order for students to be allowed to check out books for the summer, they will need to have the **permission slip signed and returned to me by Wednesday, May 29th**.

Summer checkout by students will occur on the following dates:

- Thursday, May 30th - Wednesday, June 5th (during school)

On these dates students that attend Pioneer School and have a signed permission form on file may check out 10 books.

Books are sent home in a bag which is a great place to store the books over summer. Students may return books at our Open House in the fall or the first day of school. All books checked out during the summer will need to be returned before students will be allowed to check out books during the 2024-2025 school year. Lost or damaged books will incur a fine.
